

- **Prosthodontics**

Department of Prosthodontics deals with restoration of oral & dental structures using life like prosthesis to recreate lost function & aesthetics.

The treatment facilities provided include complete dentures, removable & fixed partial dentures, maxillofacial prosthesis including obturators, various splints to stabilize fracture of jaw bones along with cosmetic dentistry.

The department offers comprehensive training for undergraduate students that enable them to expertise in dealing with completely edentulous and partially edentulous patients.

Practical training includes complete denture and cast partial denture construction on stone models, where as the fixed partial denture exercises are done on phantom heads.

The clinical training is designed to provide the students with initial exposure on patient simulators, the simulators being so realistic that all clinical procedures can be practiced precisely in virtual reality.

There are three labs for preclinical prosthodontic work including a phantom head lab, which caters to the need of 100 students.

A separate casting and ceramic lab with the latest equipment and material is also available which is capable of functioning as a commercial dental laboratory.
